This charming cottage is owned by Rob Jarvis and is decorated by The Garden Club of Bedford.

This 2 bedroom cottage was built in 1946, part of the post WWII building boom. It is a colonial style cottage with two upstairs dormer bedrooms. The paneling, which is now painted, was a popular 1940's design element.

One of the nicest features of this home are the french doors from the Living Room that open out to a covered slate porch. A previous owner added a glass enclosed garden room. This porch/solarium also has a set of french doors that open out to a new deck that was added by the present owner.

Interesting furniture includes a Virginia made drop leaf table and a nine drawer walnut chest that came from "Cedar Hill", the Cauthorn family home.

The owner's extensive art collection is featured through out the home. This collection features many local artists, including some of the owner's work.
